BERNAR VENET

An authority on conceptual art, Bernar Venet is an award winning French artist with a career spanning four decades, exploring the notions of disorder, chance, and unpredictability with perseverance. Named Chevalier de la Légion d'Honneur in 2001, France's highest decoration, he is one of only five contemporary artists to present a solo exhibition at the Château de Versailles in France. Widely regarded and respected for his distinctive sculptures, his works have been exhibited at numerous locations around the world, from Belgium to New Zealand, and even Singapore, where they were showcased at Capella Singapore and Scotts Square. From 24th to 25th September 2012, he was in Singapore to inaugurate the opening of his debut exhibition here, and shared a few words with MillionaireAsia.
